ADOPT MOVEMENT AND PLAY POLICY

Pogo Park, a 501(c)3 nonprofit agency in Richmond, will adopt and implement policies that support families and caretakers of children to be active at Elm Playlot, a small, neighborhood park that lies in the center of Richmond's Iron Triangle neighborhood.

Effective immediately, Pogo Park commits to the following activities to support our Movement and Play Policy:

- * provide a safe, welcoming, and stimulating place for children to play outside and be physically active
- * build an outdoor stage designed to foster movement
- * build a hillside slide that encourages children to run up and slide down
- * create comfortable places for caretakers of young children to sit and rest in the shade and watch over their children playing (by supporting the basic needs of parents, we can support the active play needs of children)
- * build a rocking chair in our park where parents can breastfeed their children
- * partner with other agencies including First 5, BBK, city of Richmond's Recreation Department, Weigh of Life, and Opportunity West to provide programming at the park that encourages children to be physically active
