

IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO COMPLETE THE 2020 CENSUS

If you already responded, **THANK YOU!** Your response helps make sure that our county will have more resources to meet our communities' needs.

If you haven't responded, you only have until **September 30th** to be counted. You can do it online, over the phone, or using the paper form you received in the mail. Non-response follow-up has started. That means someone from the Census Bureau may visit your home if you haven't responded yet.

REMEMBER

The census determines our political representation and funding for critical services like WIC, head start, libraries, and school meals for the next **TEN YEARS!** In Contra Costa County, we're seeing that many of our neighbors in areas with young children, communities of color, and low-income families still need to respond.

NOTHING has changed about who counts. *Everybody counts!* Babies, grandparents, friends or relatives staying with you, and anyone else who uses your address. **NOTHING** has changed about the ways your answers are protected. The census bureau **CANNOT** share your information with anyone, including other government departments, and there is **NO** citizenship question.
